WhatsApp FOR ST. MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL COMMUNICATION

St. Michael the Archangel Council is going to use WhatsApp to communicate across our Council. We will create a Council-wide Community, and Officer Community, and Communities for each Activity St. Michael the Archangel sponsors.

WhatsApp is free to download messenger app for smartphones. The service is very similar to text messaging service and you can also use Whatsapp on your computer, simply go to the Whatsapp website and download it to Mac or Windows.

Our Worthy Recorder, Nick McGinnis, has set up our WhatsApp Community and will be glad to provide oneon-one help to anyone who needs assistance.

Here is how to get started:

- Install the app from the Play Store (<u>https://andauth.co/rhSlvO</u>) (Android) or App Store (<u>https://andauth.co/whatsappios</u>) (iPhone).
- -Launch the app and approve the requested permissions.

- -Enter your phone number and tap Confirm.
- -Enter the verification code received via SMS (Text) (WhatsApp may do this automatically).
- -Import existing contacts into the app (optional).
