KNIGHT'S WALL, PHASE II

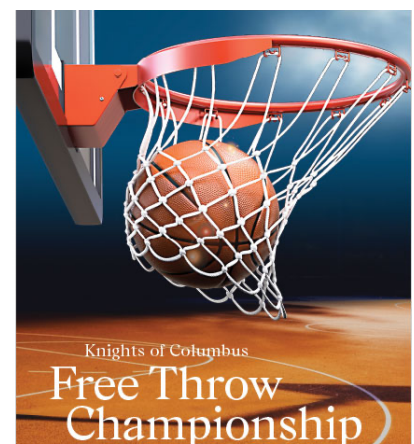
